

Environmental Studies Summer Research Fellowships (5 awards at \$2,000 each)

2022

Call for Applications: The Environmental Studies Program (ENVS) is pleased to continue to award five \$2,000 Environmental Studies Summer Research Fellowships for summer 2022. These fellowships will be for ENVS Master's students and Ph.D. students in the ESSP program. These fellowships are designed to support any aspect of master's or doctoral research and writing. Funds may be used for direct research costs such as travel or fieldwork (in compliance with any UO COVID-19 restrictions), or to compensate for time devoted to data analysis, research, or writing.

Eligibility and Criteria: Graduate students who demonstrate timely progress toward degree completion, describe a compelling research project, provide a clear plan for summer research, and show financial need will be most competitive for these Summer Research Fellowships. The fellowship cannot be held at the same time as another summer GE position, and students without access to summer GEships or other summer funding through their focal departments will receive highest priority for these fellowships. Master's students can only hold this Fellowship one time.

Application Deadline: May 6, 2022

Application Materials: Completed application must include the following materials:

- 1-2 page maximum (single-spaced) Proposal that includes: (1) explanation of the research project, (2) plan for summer research, (3) summary of degree progress to date, and (4) explanation and justification of financial need (please list other sources of summer funding)
- 2-page maximum CV
- Short email from your advisor that (1) attests to the probability of progress on the proposed research during Summer 2022, (2) confirms timely degree progress, and (3) verifies any limits on funding availability through the focal department

Application Submission: Submit completed applications to the ENVS Office Manager Monica Guy at monica@uoregon.edu and Graduate Coordinator nadams12@uoregon.edu. Advisors should send their statements of support directly to these two email addresses for Monica Guy and Nathan Adams.

Fellowship Requirements: Each fellowship holder must submit a 1-page (single spaced) final report and a photograph or two to capture the essence of the research by October 1, 2022. The report should explain precisely how the fellowship helped advance the research during the summer, outlining specifically how proposed goals were met. Submit these reports to ENVS Graduate Coordinator Nathan Adams at nadams12@uoregon.edu. Fellows will be featured on the ENVS webpage and in other publicity.
