Research Paper Contract

Research Paper: Students must complete an article-length research paper no later than their sixth term of enrollment (excluding summer). Research shall begin no later than Fall term of the second year and must be completed by the following Spring term. Research papers will be judged by a standard of readiness for submission for publication at a scholarly journal, and evaluated relative to that standard as follows: high pass, pass, low pass, or fail. A grade of fail or failure to complete the paper will be a significant factor during the "end-of-second-year" review. A Master's degree will be awarded to students who pass the Research Paper, provided they have completed all of the department's first and second year coursework requirements (see Appendix II of PhD requirements) and have met the minimum Graduate School requirements for the Master's degree.
